# Who has to be trained?

## What it is about?

If an employee has certain deseases, he is not allowed to work

&

Transfer of ownership



## When do I have to stop working?

A stool sample has proofed pathogenic germs

You have diarrhea with more than two thin fluid stools a day

You have high ague with heavy head, abdomen and/ or joint pain



#### When do I have to stop working?

You have milky white diarrhea with a high fluid loss

You recognize a yellow colour of your eyes and your skin, you feel week and you are anorexic

You have wounds or open parts of skin deseases, the skin is florid, greasy watery and engorged. An useful bandage is not possible



# What do I do with such evidence, or if I am not sure?


1. Inform your employer

2. Go to the doctor for a medical check up

3. Keep on informing your employer

# recapitulation

Diarrhea and stomach problems are serious. If your are not sure- go to the doctor. High ague is often a symptom of serious deseases. Watch your body.

Inform yourself about medical preventative measures and immunizations. If you are ill during your holidays visit your doctor at home before you start working.

Keep an eye on every little wound. Cover your wounds (even at your hands). You can use water resistant plaster or gloves.

# Summary of the results

As an employee working at the food industry you have the responsibility that no other person gets a desease from you. Think of the infection protection act.

Take care with your health and watch out for signs of deseases within the meaning of the infection protection act.

Follow the hygiene instructions- always.

You have the responsibility. If there is a violation against the infection protection act you can be punished with a monetary penalty up to 25 000 € or either imprisonment up to 5 years.
